Orquesta Guadalupana Baja California is a youth orchestra from Tijuana, Mexico, based in a Roman Catholic Church, and dedicated to bringing glory to God, and honor to the Blessed Virgin Mary under Her title, Our Lady of Guadalupe, The Patroness of the Americas. Orchestra members practice acts of mercy by visiting nursing homes, orphanages, homeless camps and installing crosses above unmarked common graves. After teaching music in California for 30 years, Music Director Ron Wakefield abandoned everything and moved to Mexico where he founded Orquesta Guadalupana in 2018. Orquesta Guadalupana is thrilled to announce that they will tour Italy in 2027.

# Holy Family Catholic Church Choir Adan Fernandez, Director of Music Glendale, California

The Music Ministry at Holy Family Catholic Church in Glendale, CA, encompasses a vibrant and diverse ensemble of choirs, including the St. Cecilia Chorale, Filipino Chorale, Coro Guadalupano, Cherubim and Seraphim Children's Choirs, Archangels Youth Chorus, Cantus Handbell Choir, and Praise Band. These ensembles have performed for esteemed events such as the Benedict XVI Institute for Sacred Music and Divine Worship, the Virgen de Guadalupe Festival at Forest Lawn, and Pueri Cantores at Christ Cathedral. Their repertoire spans sacred masterworks, from Duruflé's Requiem to Lauridsen's Lux Aeterna. Dr. Adán Fernández, Director of Music and Organist, earned his Doctorate in Sacred Music from the USC Thornton School of Music. He is a published composer with GIA, contributes to academic journals on liturgy and music, serves as University Organist at California Lutheran University, and teaches Music Theory at the Colburn School.

# California State University Northridge Youth Philharmonic Dean Anderson, Director of Orchestral Studies Northridge, California

The Cal-State University - Northridge (CSUN) Youth Philharmonic was originally formed in 1970 as the Valley Young People's Orchestra under the leadership of Dr. Thomas Osborn. The youth orchestra was invited by CSUN to take residency in 1976 and the name was changed to the CSUN Youth Orchestra Academy. Since then, it has flourished under the guidance of subsequent music directors such as David Avshalomov, Wes Kenney, Jerry Leudders, Dr. John Roscigno, and currently with Dr. Dean Anderson. Due to the increase of demand for more youth orchestra opportunities and youth music education in the community, two additional ensembles were created to better serve students of different playing levels. The Camerata and the Youth Symphony were created in 1991 under the leadership of Kimberley Blake - Kilgore, who still currently leads the Camerata with the Youth Symphony under the leadership of Elizabeth Blake. These three ensembles comprise the CSUN Youth Orchestras Program (CSUNYO). The program currently maintains a growing roster of approximately 140 talented young students.

Dean Anderson is frequently engaged as a guest conductor with professional orchestras around the globe. Most recently, he conducted II Barbiere di Siviglia in Pisa, Italy and previously orchestras such as the Orquesta del Festival Gaudix Clásica in Spain, and the Orchestra Filarmonica Campana in Cervinara, Italy. He has been the Music Director and Artistic Director for the Sea Coast Symphony for more than a decade.
